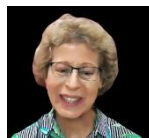

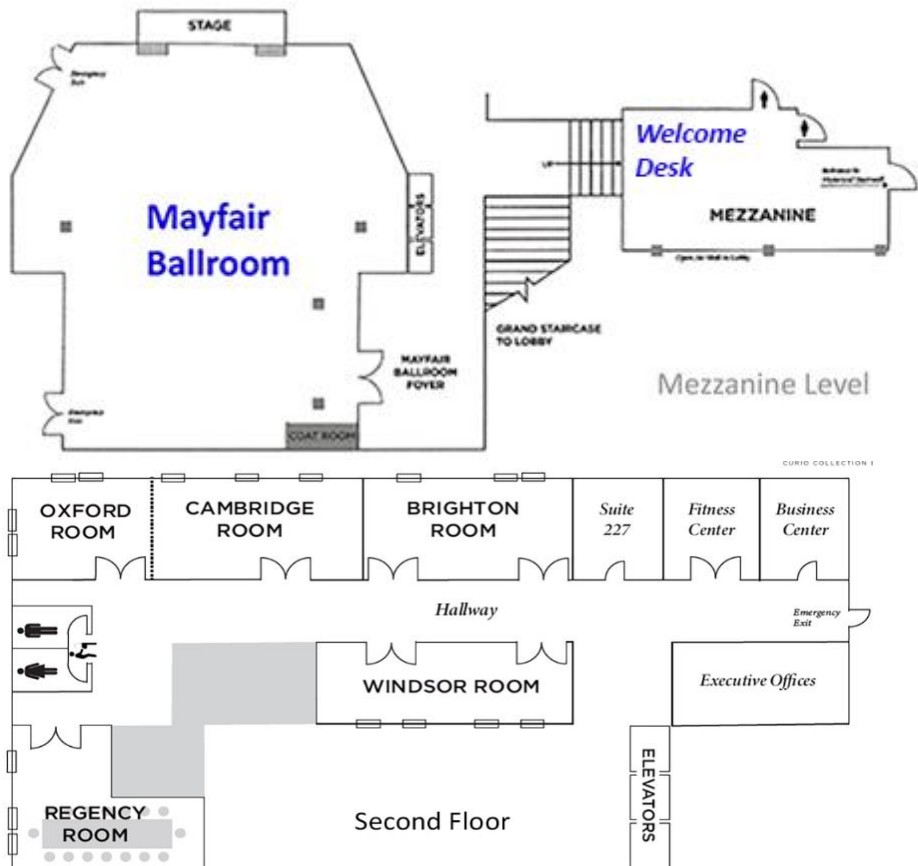

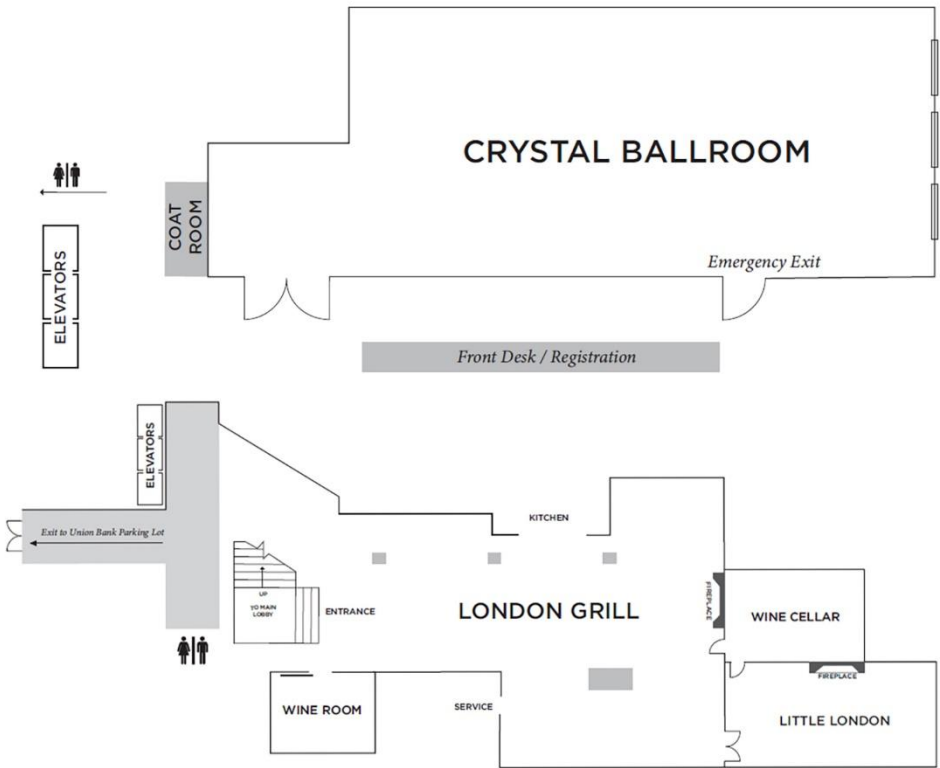


Mission Statement of the IPBA

Standing Policy of the IPBA

Sellers and buyers of perfume bottles must conduct their business dealings with honesty, integrity, and in accordance with the law among themselves and with the public. A seller (or buyer) is defined as any person offering any perfume bottle or related item for sale (or any person interested in acquiring a perfume bottle or related item), regardless of whether that person is a full-time or part-time dealer, or a collector. Sellers should truthfully and accurately represent all items to the extent known as to condition, age, and manufacture/origin. The members of the Board of Directors of the IPBA may not become involved as a third party in business transactions between members. Each member must take responsibility for their sales, and equally, for their purchases.

IPBA Annual Meeting

April 26, 2025

The Benson Hotel, Portland, OR

The membership will vote on the following proposed amendments to the Bylaws.

As we continue to evolve and strengthen our association we recognize the immense effort and dedication required to plan and execute a successful convention each year. The role of the Convention Chair has grown significantly, and after careful consideration, we have decided to split this position into two roles to better distribute the workload and ensure continued success.

By dividing the responsibilities, we can relieve some of the burden from a single individual while allowing for greater focus, efficiency, and collaboration. This change will help us continue delivering the exceptional convention experience our members look forward to while making the role more manageable for those who volunteer their time and expertise.

The change in the Bylaws is a reorganization of the positions. While we are adding an Associate Convention Chair position – we are absorbing the Recording Secretary job duties in order to maintain our number of Directors at ten (10). As such, we need to amend our Bylaws in regard to the Board of Directors' change in duties.

Please find the proposed changes below:

In order to clarify the changes, the old language is stricken through, and the new language is underlined:

ARTICLE VI - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SECTION 2.

NUMBER: The number of Directors shall consist of no fewer than five (5) nor more than ten (10) Members in good standing. Each Director also shall be an Officer of the Association (an "Officer-Director"). The number of Officer-Directors may be changed from time to time within the minimum and maximum by the Board without further amendment to the Bylaws. Officer-Directors of the Association shall include the President, Vice President, International Vice President, Treasurer, Membership Secretary, ~~Recording Secretary~~, Senior Convention Chair, Associate Convention Chair, Publications Chair, Webmaster, and Immediate Past President. These positions may be combined and held by one person who shall hold one vote.

SECTION 4.

(A) NOMINATING COMMITTEE: Nominations for Officer-Directors shall be submitted to the Board by the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee shall consist of not less than three Members appointed by the Board not less than one-hundred-and-eighty (180) days prior to the Annual Membership Meeting at which the election is to take place. The Board may provide input to the Nominating Committee as to potential candidates, but may not dictate who the Nominating Committee may nominate. Names of candidates also may be submitted to either the President or the ~~Recording Secretary~~ Membership Secretary for transmittal to the Nominating Committee by any Member, not less than one-hundred-and-sixty (160) days before the Annual Membership Meeting. The Nominating Committee shall review the qualifications of each of the candidates submitted for office but need not limit its choice of nominees to the candidates submitted either by the Board or by Members. Members of the Nominating Committee may not be nominated for a Board position. Insofar as is reasonably possible, the Nominating Committee shall ensure that the membership of the Board is representative of the Membership both in geographic area and by trade area (e.g., collectors, dealers, industry representatives). The Board may reject any candidate nominated by the Nominating Committee, in which event the Nominating Committee shall then nominate a different candidate. The Nominating Committee shall obtain the agreement of any candidate it proposes to nominate that the candidate shall serve if elected.

ARTICLE VII – OFFICERS

SECTION 1. OFFICERS: The elective Officers of the Association shall be the President, Vice President, International Vice President, Treasurer, Membership Secretary, ~~Recording Secretary~~, Senior Convention Chair, Associate Convention Chair, Publications Chair, Webmaster and Immediate Past President, and any other elective Officer which the Board in its discretion may designate up to a maximum number of Officer-Directors permitted under Article VI, Section 2 of these Bylaws. ~~The positions of Membership Secretary and Recording Secretary may be combined and held by one person.~~ Each elective Officer of the Association also shall be a Director of the Association and shall be elected by the Membership in accordance with Article VI, Section 4 of these Bylaws.

SECTION 3. POWERS AND DUTIES:

~~**(E) RECORDING SECRETARY:** Subject to the direction and control of the Board, the Recording Secretary shall (a) maintain accurate records of the proceedings of all Board and Membership Meetings, (b) certify the Bylaws, the resolutions of the Members, the Board and any Committee, and other documents of the Association as true and correct copies thereof, and (c) keep these Bylaws, with a written reference to all amendments thereto~~

~~(F)~~ **(E) MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY:** Subject to the direction and control of the Board, the Membership Secretary shall (a) be responsible for the annual collection of dues from the Members, and (b) keep accurate records of the Membership c) maintain accurate records of the proceedings of all Board and Membership Meetings, (d) certify the Bylaws, the resolutions of the Members, the Board, and any Committee, and other documents of the Association as true and correct copies thereof, and (e) keep these Bylaws, with written reference to all amendments thereto.

~~(G)~~ **(F) PUBLICATIONS CHAIR:** Subject to the direction and control of the Board, the Publications Chair shall (a) be responsible for the Association's publications, including the Perfume Bottle Quarterly and the Annual Membership Directory, (b) negotiate and obtain services for printing and mailing of publications, and (c) coordinate photographic coverage of the Association's Annual Convention and any other events.

~~(H)~~ **(G) SENIOR CONVENTION CHAIR:** Subject to the direction and control of the Board, the Convention Chair shall (a) be responsible for all aspects of the Association's Annual Convention, (b) be responsible for all financial expenditures for the Convention, (c) negotiate all convention-related contracts, (d) appoint a Show Chair, a Registration Chair, and any other chairs necessary to coordinate efforts to plan and conduct the Annual Convention, and (e) research and report to the Board for the Board's determination of the location for the next two annual conventions that have not already been scheduled.

(H) ASSOCIATE CONVENTION CHAIR: Subject to the direction and control of the Board, and in coordination with the Senior Convention Chair, the Associate Convention Chair shall (a) assist in the planning and execution of the Association's Annual Convention, (b) coordinate with the Local Planning Committee and volunteers to support convention logistics, (c) assist in developing programming, Collector Sessions, and special events to enhance the attendee experience, (d) oversee the design and production of convention materials, signage, and welcome materials, and (e) support the Senior Convention Chair in organizing and managing on-site convention operations, including the Welcome Desk, volunteer coordination, and post-convention wrap-up tasks.

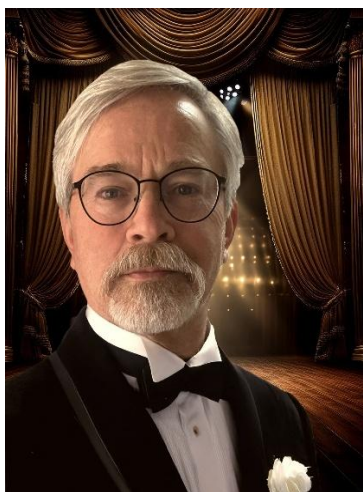
